Joanne Edworthy left the Royal Northern College of Music to work with Glyndebourne Festival Opera. Roles performed include Hansel (*Hansel & Gretel*) and Siebel (*Faust*) with Welsh National Opera & televised for Channel Four. Cherubino (*Nozze di Figaro*) at Edinburgh Festival and Hansel and Meg Page (*Falstaff*) with Palace Opera at South Bank Centre. Title roles in Handel's *Xerxes* and *Amadigi*, New Chamber Opera and Lucia (*Thieving Magpie*), British Youth Opera.

Solo concert work includes performances at Christchurch Cathedral, St Martin in the Fields, Sheldonian Theatre and St John's Smith Square and Canadian Embassy.

Joanne is a recipient of a Wingate Foundation Scholarship and Countess of Munster Award.
